- 4. Organizing Bhagidari workshop of market traders associations, various department of the Govt. of Delhi.
- 5. Display of advertising panels at various places like coaches of metro trains.
- 6. Educative messages through advertisements on FM Radio about various provisions of Delhi Value Added Tax.
- 7. 24 hours Helpline with telephone No.: 1800 11 00 66 (Toll free)
- 8. Setting of stall in the India International Trade Fair.
- 9. By organizing workshop at different market places of Delhi.
- 10. By personal interaction of officers with public and dealers during public meeting hours daily between 12 Noon to 1.00 P.M.
- 11. By allowing inspections of record and issuing copies of documents on payment of prescribed fees.
- 12. By advisory visit of the officers at the business premises of the dealers.
- 13. By providing citizen friendly atmosphere for the visitors.
- 14. By providing informative display boards in the premises.
- 15. By providing all the circulars, notifications and other orders related to DVAT Act & Rules and VAT Department displayed on departmental website accessable to public.
- 16. By providing adequate Law Books and study material including newspapers for the use of public and their representatives.
