Vide order dated 23-03-2020 in Suo motu petition(Civil) No.3/2020 titled In RE: Cognizance for Extension of Limitation the Hon'ble Supreme Court has directed that the period of limitation, whether condonable or not, prescribed under the general law or special is 's, shall stand extended w.e.f 15-03-2020 till further orders to be passed by the Court in the matter and this order is binding within the meaning of Article 141 on all Courts/Tribunals and Authorities.
- 2. Furt & r, vide order dated 27th April, 2021 in the same petition the Hon'ble Supreme Cou has restored the order dated 23rd March, 2021 and in continuation of the order d & 3th March, 2021 directed that the period(s) of limitation, as prescribed under ny general or special laws in respect of all judicial or qausi-judicial proceedings, whether condonable or not, shall stand extended till further orders.
- representation also has been received from the Secretary Sales Tax Bar Association (Regd.) requesting to issue necessary instructions to all concerned officers in this regard.
 - In light of the above, all assessing and objection hearing authorities, designated under DVAT Act, 2004 are advised to adhere to the orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court while dealing with the limitation period in respect of suo motu review, review, rectification, application and objection petition under the various provisions.
- However, appeals which are filed and are pending can continue to be heard and disposed off as per the existing provision of the DVAT Act, 2004.
