This common order is to dispose of 15 applications MA. No. 564-578/22, filed u/s Regulation 17 of Delhi (VAT) Appellate Tribunal Regulation, filed by the appellant-applicant with prayer for restoration of appeals nos. 368-382/22 which came to be dismissed in default of appearance on 16/08/2022.

Learned counsel for the appellant-applicant submits that on 16/08/2022 he could not appear as he could not move out because of self imposed home quarantine, on account of fever.

Record reveals that on 16/08/2022, none appeared on behalf of the appellant although the appeals were taken up twice. Learned counsel submits that he had requested/proxy counsel to appear before this Appellate Tribunal but he could not appear in time.
