Learned CA submits that after the disposal of the objections by Learned OHA, one "C" form has been received by the dealer and its copy placed on record.

It is further submitted that as against the balanced demand, the dealer has deposited a sum of Rs. 12,322/- and this appeal be entertained.

Learned Counsel for the Revenue has no objection to the entertainment of the appeals, in view of this submission put forth by Learned CA.

Since the applicant has deposited a sum of Rs. 12,322/- as against the total demand of Rs. 16,767/- i.e. towards additional tax and interest, the application is disposed of and appeal is entertained without calling upon the applicant to deposit any further amount.
